

Guidelines for the Registration and Recognition of Startups

↓ ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR GIVING STARTUP RECOGNISITION

- a) Any entity willing to get recognised as startup in Uttarakhand shall fulfill all the below mentioned conditions
 - The Startup should be an entity incorporated as a private limited company (as per the Companies Act 2013) or registered as a partnership firm (under the Partnership Act, 1932 or a limited liability partnership (under the Limited Liability Partnership Act, 2008) AND
 - The startup should have been incorporated in Uttarakhand or should operate from Uttarakhand and employs at least 50 percent of its total qualified workforce from Uttarakhand, which shall not include contract employees AND
 - An entity shall be considered as a startup up to 7 years from the date of its incorporation and in case the entity is operating in the engaged in the biotech sector, up to 10 years from the date of its incorporation AND
 - Turnover should be less than INR 25 Crores in any of the previous financial years
 AND
 - Such an entity should not be an extension of existing family business; or formed by splitting up or reconstruction of a business already in existence AND
 - The Startup should be working towards innovation / improvement of existing products, services and processes and should have the potential to generate employment / create wealth. An entity formed by splitting up or reconstruction of an existing business shall not be considered a "Startup
- b) In case, any entity which has been recognised as startup by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), the startup shall fulfill the below condition to get recognistion under Startup Uttarakhand
 - The startup should have been incorporated in Uttarakhand and should operate from Uttarakhand or employs at least 50 percent of its total qualified workforce from Uttarakhand, which shall not include contract employees


Visiting the Portal


Creating the User Id

- The startup should have a valid e-mail id, Mobile Number and a legal entity (as defined in Uttarakhand startup policy) to start registration process
- The startup should fill the basic details like name of the entity, name of the founder, selection of the user name and password to create an user id on the startup portal




Filling the details of Startups and uploading required Documents

- Once the user account is created, the startup is required to filling a standard form asking for the following details
 - registration details of the entity (nature of entity, industry, sector, Category, registration number, name of entity, date of incorporation, PAN number (Uploading of the certificate of incorporation)
 - certificate number of DPIIT recognition (If applicable)
 - address of the entity,
 - number of founders, co-founders and employees,
 - stage of the startup (ideation, Validation, Early Traction, Scaling),
 - IP Assets of the startups
 - description about innovation, business model,
 - Any awards/recognition received by the entity
 - What is the problem the startup is solving
 - How does the startup propose to solve this problem
 - What is the uniqueness of the solution
 - What is the revenue model of the startup
 - Upload the Pitch Deck
 - Giving Declaration




Selection of the Nodal Agency and Submitting the Application

 Once the application form is filled with all the required information, the startup can submit its application after selecting the desired Nodal Agency for further action




Examination of Application by Nodal Agency and forwarding its Recommendation

 Nodal Agency after examination of the application and documents submitted by startups shall give its recommendation to Task Force



Tracking the Application by the Startups

• The startups can track the status of their application by logging into their account



The Decision of Task Force on giving Recognitions to Startups

 Considering the recommendation of the Nodal Agency and subject to the fulfillment of all required conditions for recognition, the Task Force shall take a decision on giving recognition to the startups

Issuance of the Certificate

 The applications which are shortlisted by the Task Force for giving startup recognition shall be issued online a Certificate of Recognition

Eligibility after being recognised as Startup

- Once an entity get recognition, it shall become eligible to the benefits and incentives under the Uttarakhand startup policy for which a separate online application shall be made by the recognized startups.
- The distribution of the benefits and incentives to the startups who have applied for the same shall be subjected to the approval of the committee.
